Credit Value Definition

The basic unit of academic work is the "full credit" with a credit value of Three categories of courses that do not contribute to the 1. 0. During the Fall Term and Winter Term, a course which spans both terms normally represents three class contact hours or equivalent per week plus laboratory and/or supplementary instruction as required. Each term contains twelve weeks of instruction. Courses offered during the Summer Term have equivalent workloads but are concentrated into a shorter period of time.

It is suggested that a course with a credit value of 1.0 is equivalent to six semester hours per week or nine-quarter hours. It should be noted, however, that courses with laboratory components could yield the equivalent of eight semester hours or twelve-quarter hours.

Course Numbering System

Effective Fall 2002 the University implemented a new course numbering system. Transcripts began to reflect this new numbering system in the Summer Term of 2003 when a new student information system was implemented. Course numbering examples are as follows:
